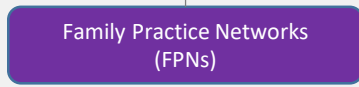

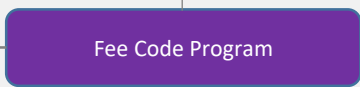

FPNs are physician-lead non-profit corporations, governed by physician Boards of Directors. FPNs provide fps with supported mechanisms to address physician and practice issues in their local areas and ultimately aid in recruitment and retention. FPNs will work collaboratively with RHAs and community (through **Collaborative Services Committees**) to achieve common health care goals and in so doing, ultimately contribute to population health outcomes. There are 4 FPNs in NL with approx. 220 FPs. FPNs are accountable for use of funding to FPRC, and report regularly on progress against goals.

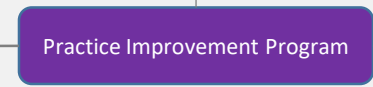


Launched in October 2018, the **Fee Code Program** undertakes fee code adjustments to support comprehensive care delivery, including:

- Increased coordination and collaboration with other primary health care providers.
- Improved patient access.
- Improved identification and management of a full range of comprehensive care services.

157 physicians are currently registered in the Fee Code Program.
Current FPRP fee codes:

- Shared Care
- Patient Care Telephone
- COPD (coming soon)



PIP comprises education, training, and supports through three “streams”:

- Clinical Knowledge and Skills
- Fee Code Integration and Support
- Practice Mgmt, Enhanced Access, Quality Improvement

Since its first offerings in Fall 2018, 209 family physicians (151 individuals) attended PIP events/modules in the areas of COPD, Care of the Older Adult, initiatives aimed at improving collaboration between family physicians and consultants, and fee code integration and support. Upcoming priorities include:

- o A comprehensive Quality Improvement program aimed at improving clinic office efficiency and enhanced patient access
- o Setting up a New Practice
- o Treatment of Addiction—Advanced Training
- o End-of-Life Care
- o Family Practice Nursing (potentially—pending Phase I outcomes)
