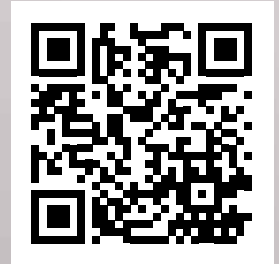

LEARNING OBJECTIVES

Social Prescribing and Singing for Health

- Define social prescribing, explain its core principles, and describe its applications in patient populations
- Describe the impact of social prescribing, particularly arts-based interventions, on patient health and well-being
- Identify and access social prescribing opportunities within the province, specifically those involving singing, to support patient engagement in these programs.

MRI Appropriateness in Musculoskeletal Imaging

- Differentiate between the appropriate indications for MRI, CT, ultrasound, and X-ray in the assessment of MSK and neuro conditions
